Beyond Form is a striking new collection of sculptures by Irish artist John Redmond, marking a significant evolution in his artistic practice.

Long celebrated for his abstract paintings, Redmond expands his practice into three-dimensional form. Each sculpture was hand-crafted by Redmond before being cast using bronze, resin and marble, at the prestigious VP Tassis foundry in Athens, Greece.

Drawing on his extensive travels and deep appreciation for art, architecture and design, *Beyond Form* translates his signature visual language into sculptural works that are both dynamic and delicately poised. Each piece reflects his ongoing investigation into the relationship between balance and form.

Redmond has successfully created sculptures that appear to be still taking shape in front of the viewer, creating a sense of dynamism and transience. Surface texture is of real significance; the sculptures are smoothly polished in order to enhance the play of light.

With this new body of work, John Redmond seamlessly bridges painting and sculpture, offering collectors and audiences a fresh perspective on his evolving artistic vision.

Flow

In *Flow*, a luminous Jade tone brings softness and vitality to an undulating, biomorphic structure. The sculpture appears to shift and evolve depending on the viewer's perspective, embodying a continuous sense of movement. Its carefully balanced composition highlights Redmond's mastery of form and spatial tension.

Arc

Arc introduces a bold, sculptural loop in a warm Sienna tone. With its open centre and sweeping lines, the piece merges geometric precision with organic fluidity. The interplay of negative space and vibrant colour creates a visually arresting presence, reinforcing the collection's theme of balance and form.

Wave

A vivid, flowing red form, *Wave* captures motion frozen in time. Rendered in a rich Cornelian hue, the sculpture curves with fluid elegance, evoking both natural movement and refined design. Balanced atop a polished gold sphere and marble plinth, it conveys a sense of tension and harmony—hallmarks of Redmond's practice.

John Redmond is an Irish contemporary artist based in Dublin.

His abstract paintings are distinguished by their bold use of colour, geometric precision, and dynamic compositions.

After a successful 30-year career in the creative industry as Creative Director of Brown Thomas, Redmond transitioned to painting full-time, bringing with him a refined visual sensibility shaped by decades of experience in design and fashion.

Colour lies at the heart of Redmond's practice. His work radiates optimism and energy, combining vivid palettes with rhythmic structures and carefully balanced compositions. Drawing inspiration from his extensive travels and his passion for architecture and design, his paintings explore the interplay between structure and spontaneity, as well as between human and abstract forms.

Redmond's style is deeply influenced by the Bauhaus movement and artists such as Wassily Kandinsky and Paul Klee. This influence is evident in his abstract, geometric approach, which embraces both discipline and freedom, resulting in works that evoke a distinctly mid-century, yet modern aesthetic.

He has exhibited widely both in Ireland and internationally, with works held in private collections across the USA, UK, Netherlands, France, Switzerland, Spain, and Ireland. Recent exhibitions, which include the sell-out *Lifelines* (2023) and *Between the Lines* (2025), have cemented his reputation as one of Ireland's most compelling artistic voices.
